

Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn- GCSE Results 2019

Yet again, pupils at Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn are celebrating another successful year in their GCSE exams, despite the challenges of the new GCSE specifications.

The hard work of pupils and staff, along with the continued support of parents, paid off once again as the school maintained its high standards in ensuring that 98% of pupils achieved at least 5 GCSE equivalent qualifications.

There was particularly pleasing performance in Science, English and Maths, with 84% of pupils achieving GCSE grades A*-C in Science, 66% in English and 64% in Maths. With the growing national and international emphasis placed on the Welsh Baccalaureate qualification, the school are also delighted that 96% of pupils achieved the standard this year.

There were some exceptional individual performances also, with 12% of pupils achieving 6 or more A* grades.

Head teacher Mrs Helen Lewis said:
